



Shapes on the Wall

Goal: Recognize and create shapes

You will need:

- Painter's tape
- Construction paper or printed shapes
- Scissors
- Shape templates
- Wall or floor space or easel



What to do:



- Use the shape templates and painter's tape to make an outline of a square, a rectangle, a triangle, and a rhombus on a wall, an easel, or the floor.
- Print and cut out shapes or make your own.
- Ask your child to fill in the shape outlines with the shape pieces. Mix and match different shapes to see how many different ways you can make one shape.

To think about:


- What other shapes can you compose?
- Are there other ways to fill in the shape outline?




Shape Pieces
