Snack Time for Frog

Inspired by A Frog in the Bog by Karma Wilson

Goal: Give frog just the right number of snacks.

You will need:

- · Pictures or small objects of things frog might like to eat
- A container in which to put frog's snacks

What to do:

- Make a container for frog's snacks. A container could be a paper or plastic bag, a bowl, or empty tissue box decorated with frog's face.
- · Arrange frog's snacks in a pile.
- Tell your child how many snacks to feed frog. Count the snacks together. This might sound like, "Give frog three flies to eat." or "Feed frog three blocks." Let's count them together, "One, Two, Three."
- Feed frog different things. Count everything that frog eats.

Other options:

- · Tape pictures of the foods frog likes to eat on his belly.
- · Make a felt frog and attach different felt foods to frog.
