

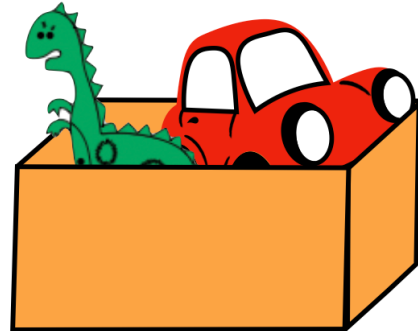
Special Hideout

Goal: Construct a special hideout for your favorite toy!

You will need:

- A container (box, cereal box, basket, etc.)
- Suggested Supplies:
 - Fabric
 - Recycled materials (cardboard box, scratch paper, egg carton)
 - Cotton balls
- May need:
 - Glue
 - Tape
 - Scissors



What to do:

- Pick your favorite toy to make a hideout for. Decide on and collect the materials you will use for your special hideout.
- Design your hideout and get to building.
 - Things to think about:
 - What will the special hideout include? A chair? A bed?
 - What will your favorite toy do in the special hideout?
 - Where will the entrance and exit be? How will you construct them?

To think about:

- Write/tell a story about the special hideout. Include positional words like “**on top**,” “**between**,” “**under**.” Include the shapes of the objects you used. Describe the colors and other features of your hideout. Include what your toy will do in the special hideout.
