

Eight Questions

Inspired by *Every Dog in the Neighborhood* by Philip C. Stead

Goal: Use data to create an infographic.

You will need:

- A partner
- Paper and pencil
- Art materials to create an infographic, for example: markers, crayons, paint, stickers

What to do:

- With a partner, create a list of eight questions designed to get to know each other better. Make sure that both of you are comfortable answering the questions on the list. The questions might focus on your interests, talents, hobbies, likes and dislikes, favorite books, foods you enjoy making or eating, or sports you like to play or watch.
- Take turns asking the questions and recording the information shared.
- Once the questions have been asked and answered, each person uses the information received to create an infographic (chart, graph, picture, table, etc.) about the other person. The purpose of the infographic is to provide a visual introduction of your partner.
- Share the infographics created with others.

To think about:

- Think about what you really want to know and remember it's important to be respectful with the questions you ask. Part of your job is to ask questions that are specific and appropriate for the other person to answer.
