


What's for Dinner?

You Will Need:


- Paper and pencil or computer/tablet



What to Do:

Plan a dinner for your family or a group of friends.

 - What questions will you ask to find out what the group would like to have for each of the following:
 - Protein
 - Vegetable
 - Fruit
 - Grains
 - Dessert
 - Beverages
 - Something else?
 - Some other considerations you may want to think about or add to your survey:
 - Allergies?
 - Dietary needs/preferences?
 - Something else?



To Think About:

- Who will you invite?
- What types of survey questions will you ask?
- How will you collect the data (answers)?
- How will you decide what dishes to serve?
- How will seasonal availability of food, special occasions, or other considerations affect your plans?
